XVIII. Lodge Rules

- A) Below are the proposed changes to the Lodge Rules to be voted on at the next LEC. Each change must have a 2/3 majority by the voting members of the LEC. Each rule will show the current version and the proposed changes.

XIX. Section V.3


- A) Current: The yell of the lodge shall be “Hyas Kloshe, Okok, T’Kope Kwiskwis”, which means “How mighty is the Silver Marmot” in Chinook Jargon.
- B) Proposed: The yell of the lodge shall be “Hyas Kloshe, Okok, T’Kope Kwiskwis”, which means “How mighty is the Silver Marmot”
- C) The Change: Removed ‘in Chinook Jargon’

XX. Section VI.3

- A) Current: At the election of the lodge officers, a majority of the chapters must be present. No less than twenty (20) youth members in good standing with the lodge must also be present at the election.
- B) Proposed: At the election of the lodge officers, a simple majority of the chapters must be present. No less than twenty (20) youth members in good standing with the lodge must also be present at the election.
- C) The Change: Added the word simple before majority.

XXI. Section VIII.3



- 
- A) Current: The lodge chief, or in their absence, the lodge secretary, shall preside at all meetings of the lodge.
 - B) Proposed: The lodge chief, or in their absence, the lodge secretary, shall preside at all meetings of the lodge. If the secretary is absent, the next officer present who presides at all meetings will be found through the order as mentioned in Section V.1
 - C) The Change: In case multiple officers are absent, there will be a clear order of who will preside at the meetings of the Lodge.


XXII. Section VIII.7


- A) Current: A majority of the voting members of the lodge executive committee shall constitute a quorum, and only youth lodge executive committee members in good standing with the lodge may vote on items of lodge business.
- B) Proposed: A majority of the voting members of the lodge executive committee shall constitute a quorum, and only youth lodge executive committee members in good standing with the lodge may vote on items of lodge business. Immediate past Lodge Chief is excluded from lodge executive committee votes
- C) The Change: Even if the immediate past Lodge Chief is a youth and therefore a youth member of the LEC, they would be exempt from voting in LEC votes.

XXIII. Section X.3

- A) Current: The chapters shall adopt Northwest Coast Indian names and totems.
- B) Proposed: The chapters shall adopt names and totems as deemed fit by lodge executive committee vote.

XXIV. Section XIV

- A) Current Section XIV:
 - B) Section XIV.1 The Lodge respects and adopts for study and ceremonial use the language, costumes, regalia, dances, and customs of the Northwest Coast Indians.

- C) Section XIV.2 Arrowmen wearing or displaying regalia while representing the Boy Scouts of America shall wear their ceremonial uniform. When appropriate, they will wear their Order of the Arrow sash.
 - D) Section XIV.3 All lodge regalia should be in accordance with the Lodge Regalia Policy as detailed in the Regalia Rules and Guidelines handbook.
 - E) Proposed Section XIV:
 - F) Section XIV.1 Arrowmen performing ceremonies of the order representing Scouting America shall wear their ceremonial uniform. When appropriate, they will wear their Order of the Arrow sash.

XXV. Section XVII.7

- A) To be added: Insignia of the Lodge may only be used with approval by vote from the lodge executive committee. Gifts from Lodge Officers and Lodge Advisers are an exception to this section.
